

# Light and Salvation

Psalms 27:1-14

Key verse 27:1

1. What does David declare confidently (1)? What is he struggling with (2)? In spite of his fearful situations, what makes him confident (3)?
2. What is the one thing David asks of the Lord (4a)? What does David want from fellowship with God (4b–5)? What is “the beauty of the Lord”? How does David respond to victory over his enemies (6)?
3. Based on his confidence, what does David pray, and why (7)? Why does God invite his people to “seek my face” (8a)? (Compare verse 4; see 2Ch 7:14) How does David respond (8b)? How can we see his face (2Co 4:6)? What else does David pray (9–10)?
4. What guidance does David seek (11-12)? And why a “level” path?
5. What is David’s resolution (13)? What is his strong exhortation to his people (14)? In this psalm, how can we cultivate our confidence that “the LORD is my light and salvation”?
